

THE GOD OF SELF-EMPTYING LOVE

The wisdom of this world,
the practice of grabbing wealth, power and authority
over people and over creation,
is not the wisdom or the path that leads to an encounter
with the God of Self-Emptying Love.

How do we come to know this God of self-emptying love? Perhaps just to ask the question is a first step. In the Gospel of John, Philip asks Jesus, "Lord, show us the Father, and we will be satisfied" (14:8). Imagine, for a moment, Jesus shaking his head, saying to Philip, "You've seen me all this time. You've been with me healing the broken-hearted, feeding the hungry, forgiving the sinner, I even washed your feet...this is what God is like!"

And we know what God is like when we know Jesus, when we see his compassion for the leper, the blind, the deaf, the rejected of his world, when we see him weeping over Jerusalem. Jesus emptied himself on the cross, giving a

blessing and a promise to the man hanging on the cross next to him because he recognized Jesus' goodness and love. When we have personal knowledge of Jesus and how he spent himself, how he poured out his love, we have come to know the God of Self-Emptying Love.

What are some of the ways you have come to know what God is like? Perhaps one of these scripture passages will remind you:

The Lord is compassion and love, slow to anger and rich in mercy. Ps. 103:8

Come to me, all you that are weary and are carrying heavy burdens, and I will give you rest. Mt. 11:28
