An Excerpt From Today's Gospel

"No one knows the Son except the Father, and no one knows the Father except the Son and anyone to whom the Son wishes to reveal him. Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am meek and humble of heart; and you will find rest for yourselves. For my yoke is easy, and my burden light."

Reflection

The Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus is such a moving Feast Day if we take the time to reflect on the love of Jesus. Do we open ourselves to the love of God poured out through his Son? Each of us is called to be love poured out in our lives. The love we have for God and for all God's creatures is evidenced by how we live our lives.

I chose this part of Matthew's Gospel because it touches the depths of our being if we take in these beautiful words of invitation to come to God -- because God cares about each of us. If we are troubled or burdened, we have only to turn to God, to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, and open ourselves to his love. I have found this passage comforting in times of distress, grief, and anguish. Turning to the beloved enables us to regain our footing amidst the storms of life.

On this special Feast Day, it is a reminder to each of us to pray in gratitude for God's love, which is freely given to us. We in turn, through our call to discipleship, are to be love poured out in our daily lives.
