"And so it must be all modesty, all gentleness, all candour and simplicity, wholly interior, spiritually alive. In a word, it must be empty of self, detached from everything."


THE EUCHARISTIC LETTER, FR. JEAN-PIERRE MEDAILLE, SJ

Reflection

Entering day three of the pilgrimage, our group retraced some of the day's prior steps and then followed the path of Father Jean Pierre Medaille, SJ, as we expanded our exploration to discover the Jesuit College he attended as a boy, and St. Michael's Church where he was baptized and where he worshiped. In the context of his spiritual home and the times in which he lived, the Holy Spirit inspired and broke open a proclamation of love and unity that resonated

over a vast geography and time.

Our pilgrim community unfolded and came to know and further take to heart the essence of Fr. Medaille's little institute of spirituality, both the design and foundational spiritual anchors. and cause it to live by the very holiness of an infinite God
who possesses the immensity of all things."
