#### Reflection

Taken together, the readings for this Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time urge all the faithful to live fully our baptismal commitment. At baptism, we entered into a covenant with God and promised to live in and through Christ Jesus, keep His commandments and to serve Him throughout our entire lives.

These readings remind us that we walk in faith with the Holy Spirit guiding our way. If we turn to God, and remember our desire to serve as Jesus served, then we, too, can seek out the downtrodden, and lift up those bowed down. We need not look far to find people who experience themselves as outcasts, unworthy, forgotten, and overlooked.

Our readings remind us that it is in being instruments of God's mercy, through our presence and acts of generous compassion, that we assist others in finding their way to God. No matter the hardships that befall any of us in life, we have life to the fullest when we are in right relationship with the Beloved.

The final words in today's readings are comforting and inviting: "Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am meek and humble of heart; and you will find rest for yourselves. For my yoke is easy, and my burden light." Take them in and allow yourself to be held in God's embrace as you begin (or end) this day.
