## **An Excerpt From Today's First Reading**

"Abraham had now reached a ripe old age, and the LORD had blessed him in every way."

**GENESIS 24:1** 

#### Reflection

The week before my Dad died quite suddenly, he casually remarked to my Mother, "We have had a very good life together." His words stuck with us all and are a source of blessing and gratitude for us, their children. The Lord's blessings, in every way, are evident in the overall span of their lives.

Recounted in Genesis, the life experiences of Abraham and Sarah mirror the ups and downs, the challenges and blessings of life lived in fidelity to God. By

faith and action, they journeyed through life, adapting to the circumstances that were theirs. I imagine they awoke each new day to discover God present and available in the ordinariness of everyday life.

Stepping back in faith and relying on my relationship with God, remembering the blessings that come easily and those that came from my journey in difficult times, provides me with blessed reassurance.
